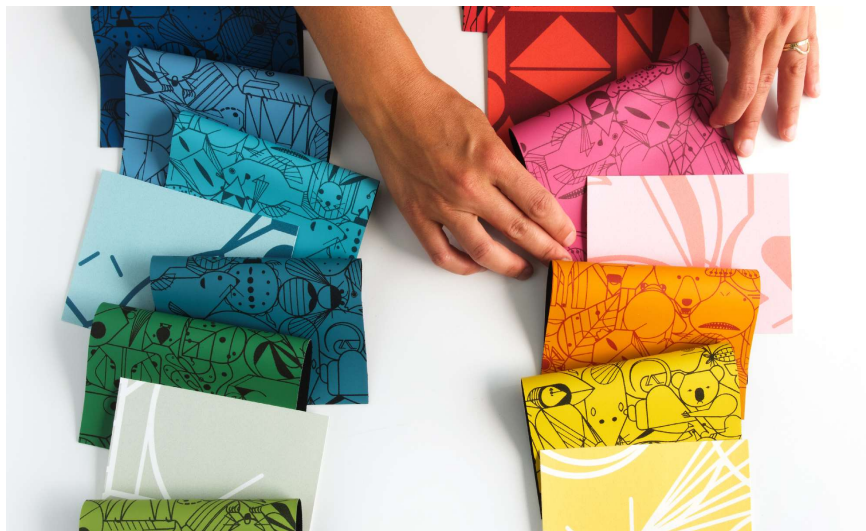


# Color, Part 2: Applied Color, Systems, Trends and Innovations

A brief history of the sources of dyes and pigments is given, and the primary dyeing and printing methods are discussed. Color systems and attempts at color standardization throughout the ages are reviewed. Color trends and the major influences shaping those trends are outlined with historical and modern examples. New color innovations coming from the lab are also introduced.
